# MINUTES Decatur Metropolitan Planning Organization Policy Board 12-01-2022

## THOSE PRESENT:

- Item 1. Chairperson Garrison called the meeting to order at 03:30 pm.
- Item 2. Approve the minutes from the last meeting.

Chairperson Garrison asked for a motion to approve the minutes from the August 17, 2022 MPO meeting. Mayor Bowling made a motion to approve the minutes as presented with a second by Councilman Ladner. The motion carried unanimously.

Item 3. Presentation – Alabama Transportation Infrastructure Bank – Mr. Louis Cardinal

Chairperson Garrison introduces Mr. Louis Cardinal with the Alabama Transportation Infrastructure Bank. Mr. Cardinal shared what the Alabama Transportation Infrastructure bank is and why it was created. The bank was created to loan money to Alabama municipalities for transportation projects. With the Alabama Transportation Bank, participates and guaranteed an "AA" rating. Participates must guarantee some form of revenue (gas tax, lodging tax, etc.). There is a current restriction of no less than \$5,000,000 per loan.

## Item 4. Election of Officers for FY 2023

- Chairperson Mayor Bowling nominated Mayor Garrison as Chairman for 2023 with a second by Councilman Ladner. Mayor Garrison is elected unanimously.
- 2) Vice-Chairperson Councilman Ladner nominated Mayor Bowling with a second from Councilman McMasters. Mayor Bowling is elected unanimously.
- Item 5. Adopt Resolution 23 01 to approve the ALDOT Bridge and Pavement Performance Targets (PM2) for the upcoming 4 year period.

Mr. Hellums explains that the PM2 is a requirement from the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act passed earlier in 2022. These are percentages pertain to pavement on the US and state roads and bridges. The MPO adopted a resolution in previous years to adopt the measures given to us by ALDOT.

Mayor Garrison calls for a motion. Mayor Heflin gave a motion with a second from Mayor Bowling. The resolution passes unanimously.

Item 6. Adopt Resolution 23–02 to amend the FY 2020 - 2023 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to add the following project:

Emergency Slide Repair on SR-24 at MP 66 (34.574156N, -87.084225W)

Mr. Hellums explains this is the land slide that occurred on SR-24 on Trinity Mountain. The roadway is down to one lane until the repair can be made. ALDOT is currently working on the repair.

Mayor Garrison calls for a motion. Mayor Bowling gave a motion with a second from Councilman Ladner. The resolution passes unanimously.

Item 7. Adopt Resolution 23-03 to amend the FY 2020 - 2023 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to add funding to the following project:

Resurfacing on SR-36 from New Cut Road (MP 16.210) to SR-3 (US-31)

Mr. Hellums explains that this an ALDOT project that will be out for bid the following day. There could be an adjustment at a future MPO meeting.

Mayor Garrison calls for a motion. Mr. Vincent gave a motion with a second from Councilman Ladner. The resolution passes unanimously.

Item 8. Adopt Resolution 23–04 to amend the FY 2020 - 2023 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to add funding to the following project:

Reconstruction of CR-684 (Church Street) from Somerville Road to Riverview Avenue in the City of Decatur

Mr. Hellums explained this is a MPO project that the Decatur City Council approved at a previous Policy Board Meeting. The utilities phase was combined with the construction phase due to a large water main under the roadway. The cost is reflective of the bid.

Mayor Garrison calls for a motion. Councilman McMasters gave a motion with a second from Councilman Pike. The resolution passes unanimously.

Item 9. Adopt Resolution 23 – 05 to amend the FY 2020 - 2023 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to add funding to the following project:

Bridge Replacement BINS 006153 and 001391 on SR-3 (US-31) over Norfolk Southern Railway

Mr. Hellums explains that is an estimated increase on the Utility Phase on the bridge replacement crossing Norfolk Southern Railway on US-31. Construction is scheduled for fall of 2023.

Mayor Garrison calls for a motion. Mr. Vincent gave a motion with a second from Mayor Bowling. The resolution passes unanimously.

Item 10. Adopt Resolution 23 – 06 to amend the FY 2020 - 2023 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to add funding to the following project:

Resurfacing on North Seneca Drive from Old Highway 24 to SR-20 (US-72A) in the Town of Trinity (PE and CN)

Mr. Hellums explained that this is an MPO project that is completed. The MPO is picking up 80% and the city will pick up 20%.

Mayor Garrison calls for a motion. Mayor Bowling gave a motion with a second from Mayor Heflin. The resolution passes unanimously.

- Items 11. Adopt Resolution 23 07 to amend the FY 2020 2023 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to delete the following projects:
  - Resurfacing on Bethel Road from Lynnwood Circle to SR-67 in the City of Priceville
  - Resurfacing on Cave Springs Road from Bethel Road to Sunset Acres Avenue in the City of Priceville
  - Resurfacing on Skidmore Road from SR-67 to Cave Springs Road in the City of Priceville

Mr. Hellums explained that this resolution is to delete the projects out of the current TIP were the projects could be combined into one project for cost savings. They will be combined in the Resolution 23-08.

Mayor Garrison calls for a motion. Mayor Heflin gave a motion with a second from Mayor Bowling. The resolution passes unanimously.

Items 12. Adopt Resolution 23 – 08 to amend the FY 2020 - 2023 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to add the following projects:

Resurfacing on the following roadways in the City of Priceville

Bethel Road from Lynnwood Circle to Kimberly Street Cave Springs Road from Bethel Road to Sunset Acres Road Skidmore Road from SR-67 to Cave Springs Road

Mr. Hellums explained that this resolution is to combine the projects deleted out by Resolution 23-07. This is for cost savings.

Mayor Garrison calls for a motion. Mayor Heflin gave a motion with a second from Mayor Bowling. The resolution passes unanimously.

Item 13. Adopt Resolution 23 – 09 awarding the Contract for the Interstate 65 Bethel Road Corridor Study to Garver LLC.

Mr Hellums explained this project was approved with the UPWP. Hartselle, Morgan County, and Priceville have all contributed their matching funds of a combined \$20,000. Graver was selected due to their knowledge of the type of study and study area.

Mayor Garrison calls for a motion. Mayor Heflin gave a motion with a second from Councilman Ladner. The resolution passes unanimously.

ALDOT representatives gave a brief update on a number of projects in the MPO Planning Area. These projects included Vaughn Bridge Road, 6<sup>th</sup> Street, West Morgan Road, Church Street, Lando Cain Road/SR 36, Cave Springs Road, Skidmore Road, Bethel Road, US 31/NS Railroad Bridges, US 36 Resurfacing, US 31 Resurfacing and streetscape, US 31 Access Management project in Hartselle, Tabernacle Road rail crossing, I-65 bridge assessment, Emergency Slide Repair on SR-24 at MP 66, and Beltline signal project.

Mr. Hellums explained to the MPO after the 2023 TIP is over, the MPO will need to look at new small projects for the 2024 TIP and 2025 TIP. He also gave an update on the bridge study ARC grant.




